



35th ESTONIAN OPEN MASTERS SWIMMING CHAMPIONSHIPS INVITATION 2024



TIME AND PLACE December 7th, 2024 in Tallinn, Nõmme swimming pool (Vabaduse pst. 156). Competition will be held in 25m indoor pool, on 6 lanes with electronic timekeeping system.

ENTRIES Final entries can be submitted through swimrankings.net or by sending competing athletes name, date of birth, events and entry times to u-klubi@u-klubi.com. Entries are open until 30.11.2024 at 23:59.

PARTICIPATION All swimmers who are licensed members of a club that is a member of the EUL or another country's federation can take part in the competitions.

AGE GROUPS Competitors have to be born in 1999 or earlier. Age groups are divided according to World Aquatics masters age groups (25-29, 30-34, 35-37 etc, 5 year range in every group). Age group is considered as of December 31, 2024. It is also possible to compete in class 0 (age 20-24, year 2004 and earlier) as EXH (not awarded with a medal of the Estonian championships, not participating in the "Supermaster" calculation or in the combined calculation of clubs).

SCHEDULE Competitions start at 13:00, warm-up 12:10 – 12:55 (access to the dressing room from 12:00). The race office is open from 11:45 at the competition venue. Heats are formed based on entry times, regardless of age group. There is a 10 min break after each event.

STARTING FEE -64 years old 13€/start; taking part in all five events 50€
65+ years old 8€/start; taking part in all five events 30€
Starting fees have to be paid by 05.12.2024 to Estonian Swimming Federation account: EE037700771008720022 (reference: MASTERS) or in cash to the race office. Please notify the federation if an invoice is needed before making the payment.



AWARDS

A one-time Estonian championship medal is awarded to a swimmer who has placed in the top three in at least one event in their age group. The medal is awarded according to the highest place achieved in the competition. All swimmers (including class 0) receive a one-time diploma.

A separate calculation according to the age coefficient is considered for the title of "Supermaster" (50 m in all styles + 100 m IM). In the "Supermaster" category, the 6 best men and women are awarded with a medal and the 10 best men and women with a prize.

The top three clubs will be awarded trophies. The ranking is determined by adding up the AQUA masters points, and the best two results per club in each event are taken into account.

ADDITIONAL INFORMATION

- The organisation of the competition is based on the World Aquatics competition regulations and the Estonian Swimming Federation's general competition guidelines. Questions not discussed in the invitation will be resolved by the referee of the competition.
- Accommodation and travel expenses are borne by the sending organisation or the participant.
- Participation in the competition is at the swimmer's own risk.
- The organiser has the right to use photos and video recordings taken during the competition.
- Every registered athlete must be ready for doping control. The athlete is obliged to follow the rules of fair play, anti-manipulation of sports competitions and sports security.
