



# ESTONIAN MASTERS SWIMMING AND OPEN CLASS CHAMPIONSHIPS 2026

- TIME AND PLACE** 6th of June 2026 in Aura Waterpark, Tartu, Turu street 10. Competition is held on one day as two sessions in 50m indoor swimming pool on 8 lanes.

- ENTRIES** Entries (including relays) must be submitted by clubs through the Swimrankings.net Entry Manager. Open class swimmers and foreign clubs may also send their entries by email to [swimming@swimming.ee](mailto:swimming@swimming.ee). All entries must be submitted no later than May 31<sup>st</sup> 2026, at 23:59. Relay named entries must be submitted in writing to the competition secretariat no later than 30 minutes before the start of the respective competition session. The organizer will publish the list of participants no later than June 2<sup>nd</sup> at 12:00. Withdrawals can be made until June 3<sup>rd</sup> at 23:59. The start lists will be published no later than June 4<sup>th</sup> at 20:00.
- PROGRAMM** The competition will be held as direct finals. Lane assignments will be based on entry times regardless of age groups – slower swimmers will start. Time limit in 800 m freestyle is 20 minutes. In case of many swimmers some swimmers might share lane.
- AGE GROUPS** Results will be recorded in all WA Masters age groups (25–29, 30–34, 35–39, etc., in 5-year intervals) and for pre-masters (20–24) for both men and women. The age group is determined based on the swimmer's age as of December 31, 2026. In the Open Class events, results will be recorded separately for men and women in the overall classification.
- CONDITIONS OF PARTICIPATION** The competition is open to all swimmers from Estonia and foreign countries born in the year 2006 or earlier, who are licensed members of a club affiliated with the Estonian Swimming Federation (EUL) or any other national federation. Swimmers in the pre-masters (20–24) age group do not take part in club overall standings, special award point calculations, and are not allowed to compete in 100+ age group relay events. A separate pre-masters relay in the 80–99 age category is permitted. In the Open Class events (see competition program, event numbers with 1000), all swimmers aged 18 and older living in Estonia who do not hold an Estonian Swimming Federation license are allowed to participate.
- STARTING FEES** €13 for individual events; the entry fee for relay events is €20 per team. Invoices for the entry fees will be issued by the Estonian Swimming Union (EUL) to clubs (to the email address of the contact person who submitted the entries) based on the status as of June 3 at 23:59.

### AWARDS

Swimmers who place in the top three in their age group in at least one event will be awarded a medal - Estonian Championship medal in championships category and competition medal in open class. Medals and diplomas can be collected from the competition secretariat after the swimmer has completed all their events.

Special prizes will be awarded to the top 10 male and top 10 female masters swimmers based on the combined points from two events according to the AQUA Masters 2025 points table.

The top three clubs will be awarded trophies based on the AQUA Masters 2025 points table. Each club's total score will include a maximum of 20 best individual results and 4 best relay results.

From each swimmer, a maximum of 3 best individual results will count towards the club ranking.

## ADDITIONAL INFORMATION

- All matters related to the organisation and conduct of the competition that are not addressed in this guide will be resolved based on the 2026 EUL General Competition Guidelines, the Estonian Masters Swimming Rules, and the World Aquatics (WA) competition regulations.
- Accommodation and travel expenses are the responsibility of the sending organisation or the athlete themselves.
- Participation in the competition is at the swimmer's own risk. By registering, the participant confirms that they have read the competition guide, have sufficient swimming ability for the selected distance(s), and that their health condition allows them to take part in the event. The participant is personally responsible for the consequences of their actions or inaction throughout the event. Participation is voluntary, and by entering the competition, the participant acknowledges all associated risks and agrees not to make any claims against the organizers for any direct or indirect damages resulting from participation.
- Each registered athlete must be prepared for doping control. Refusal to undergo or avoidance of doping control is considered a violation of anti-doping regulations. Athletes are required to comply with fair play principles, anti-manipulation rules, and sports safety regulations.
- The organizer has the right to use photos and video recordings taken during the competition.
